What is the adopted Policies Map?

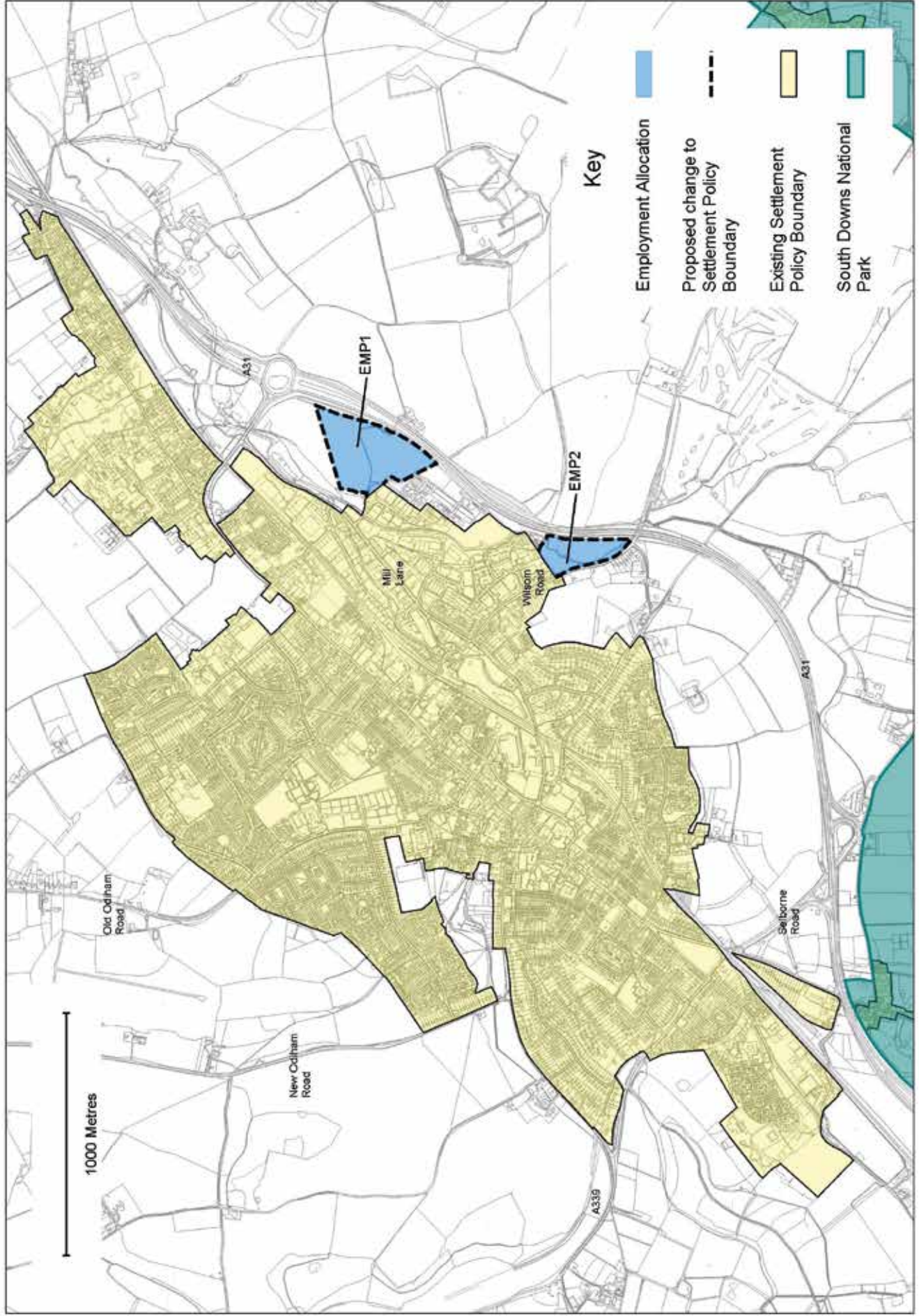

What is the purpose of the document?

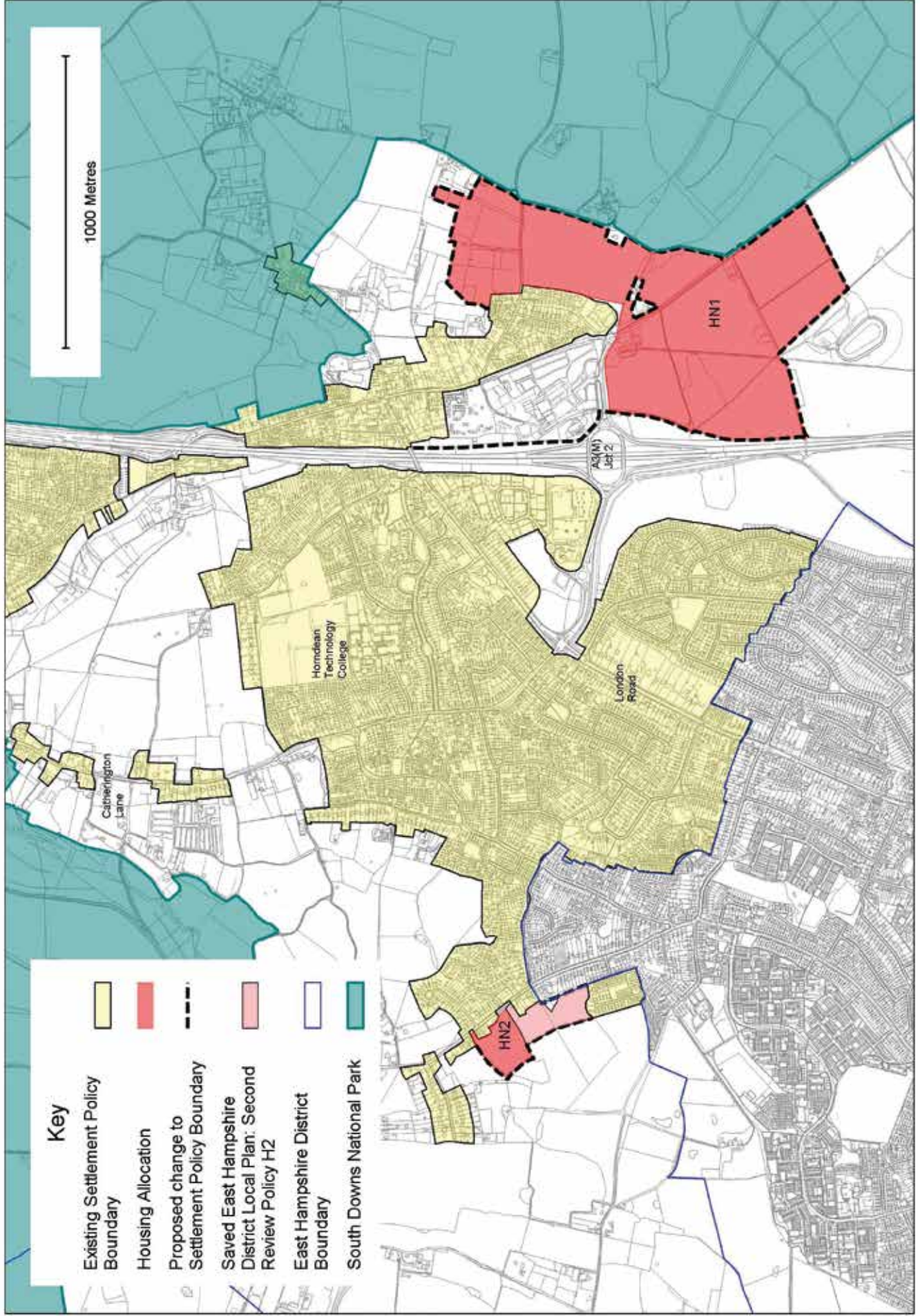

- 1.5** It must be noted that these changes to the Policies Map are now official following adoption of the Site Allocations Plan.

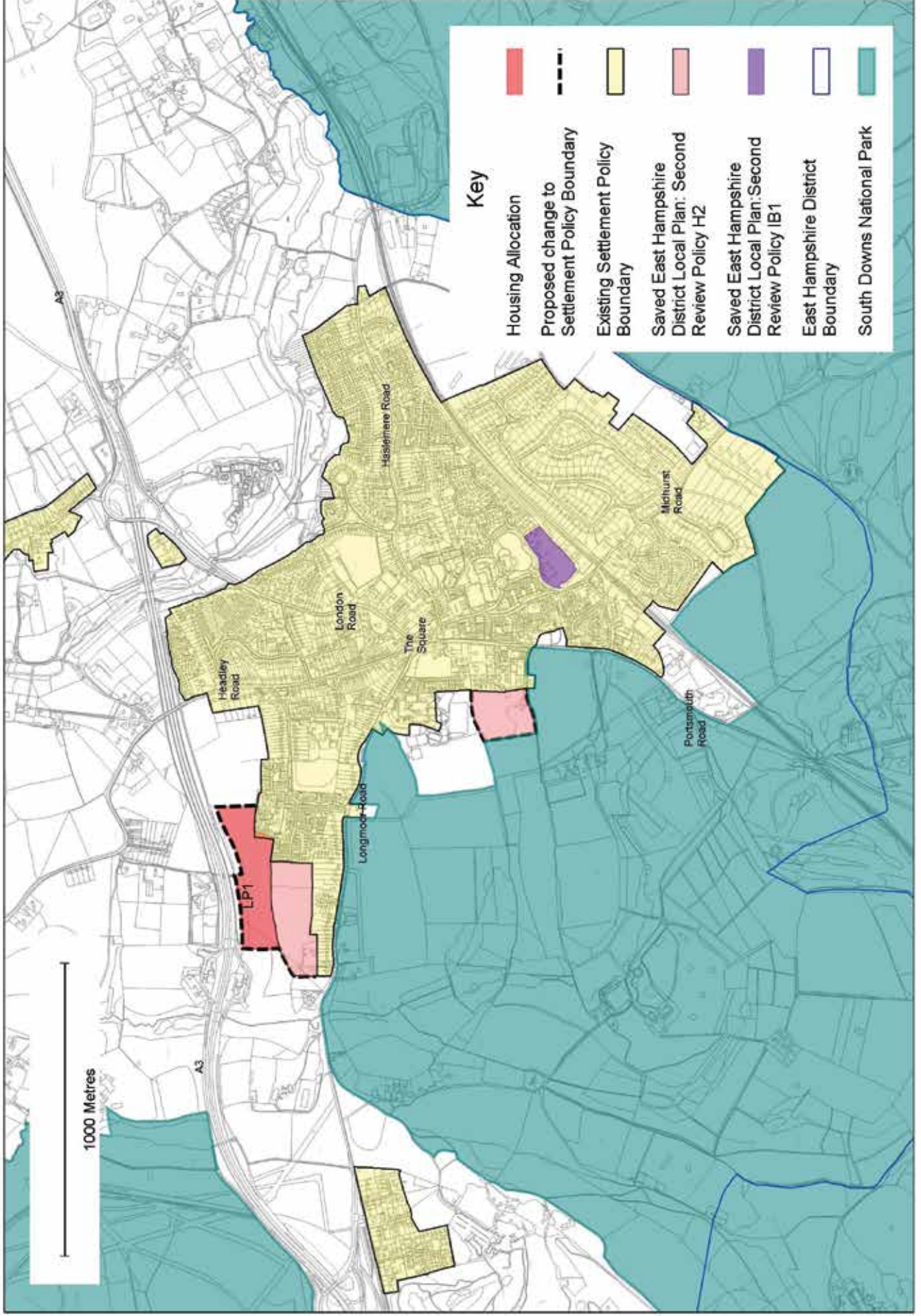


Map I - Alton

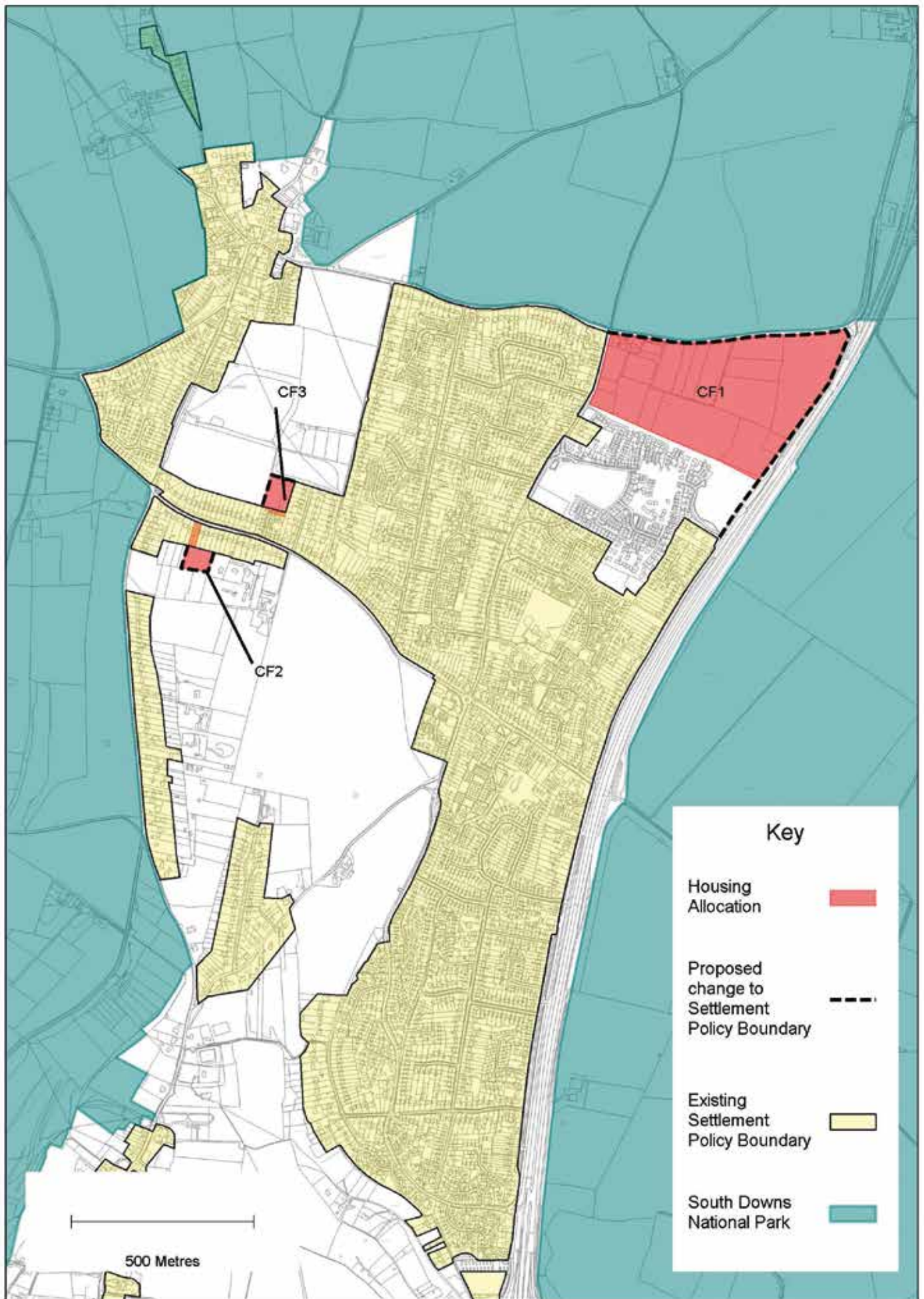


Map 2 - Horndean

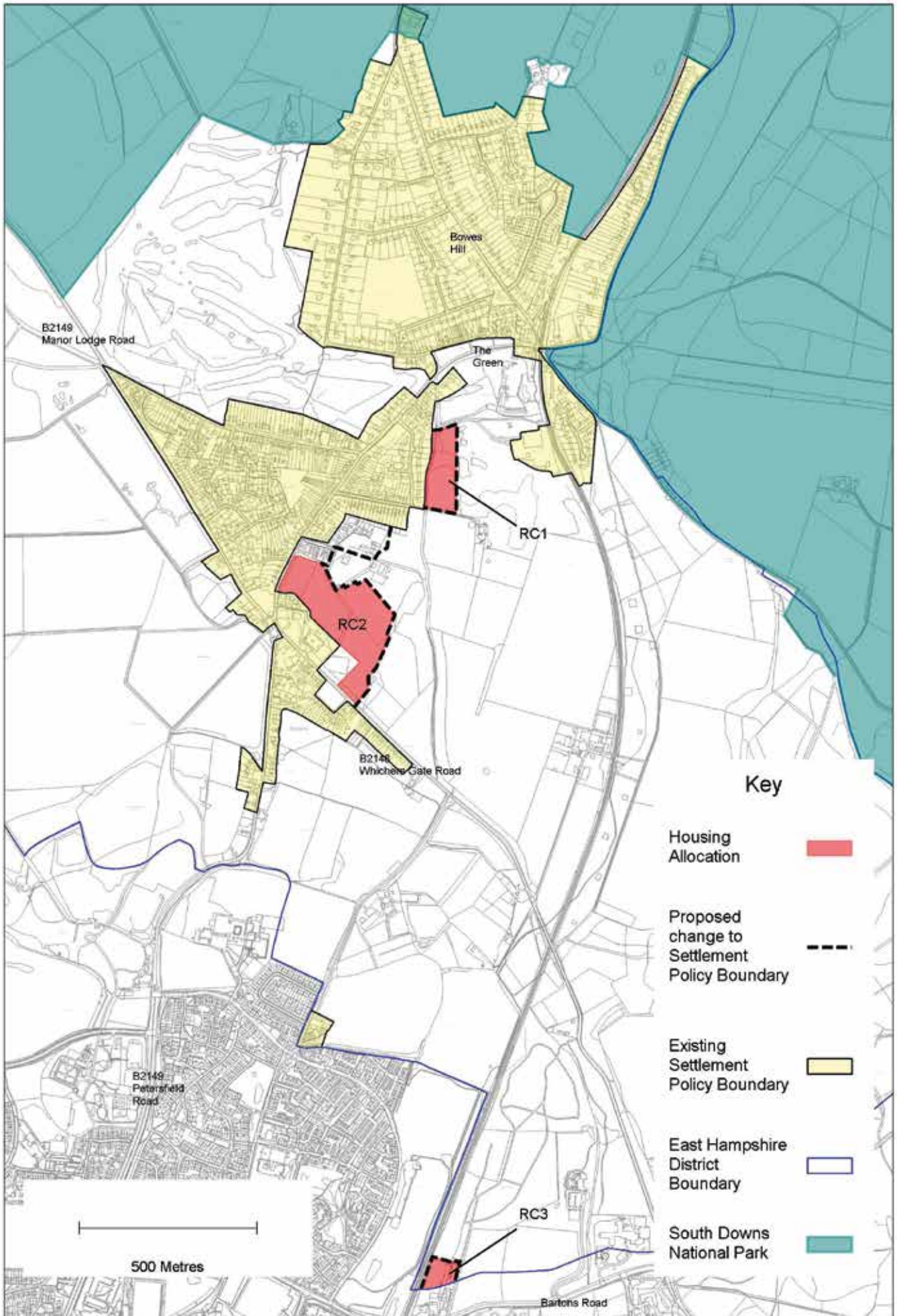




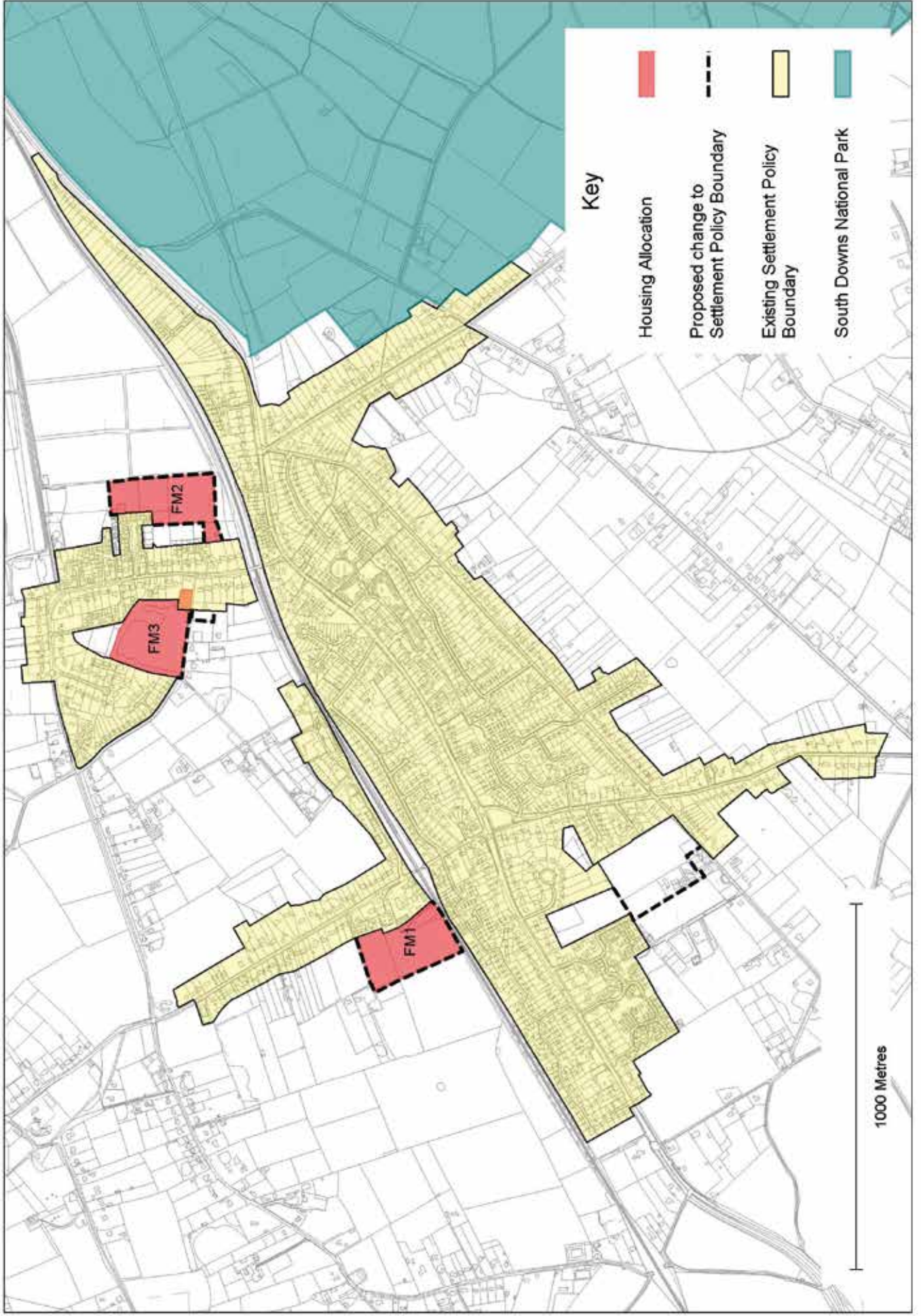
Map 4 - Clanfield



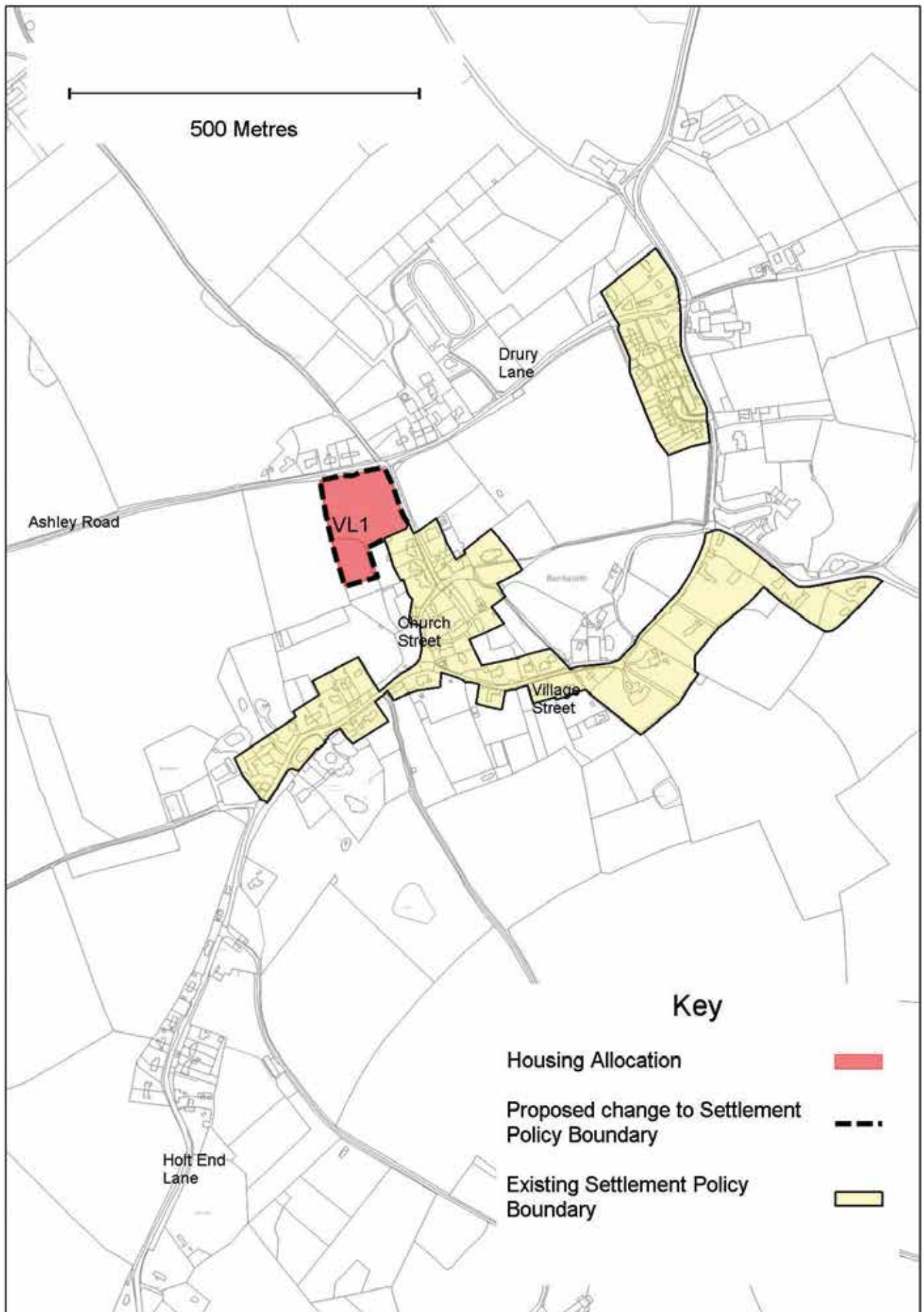
Map 5 - Rowlands Castle



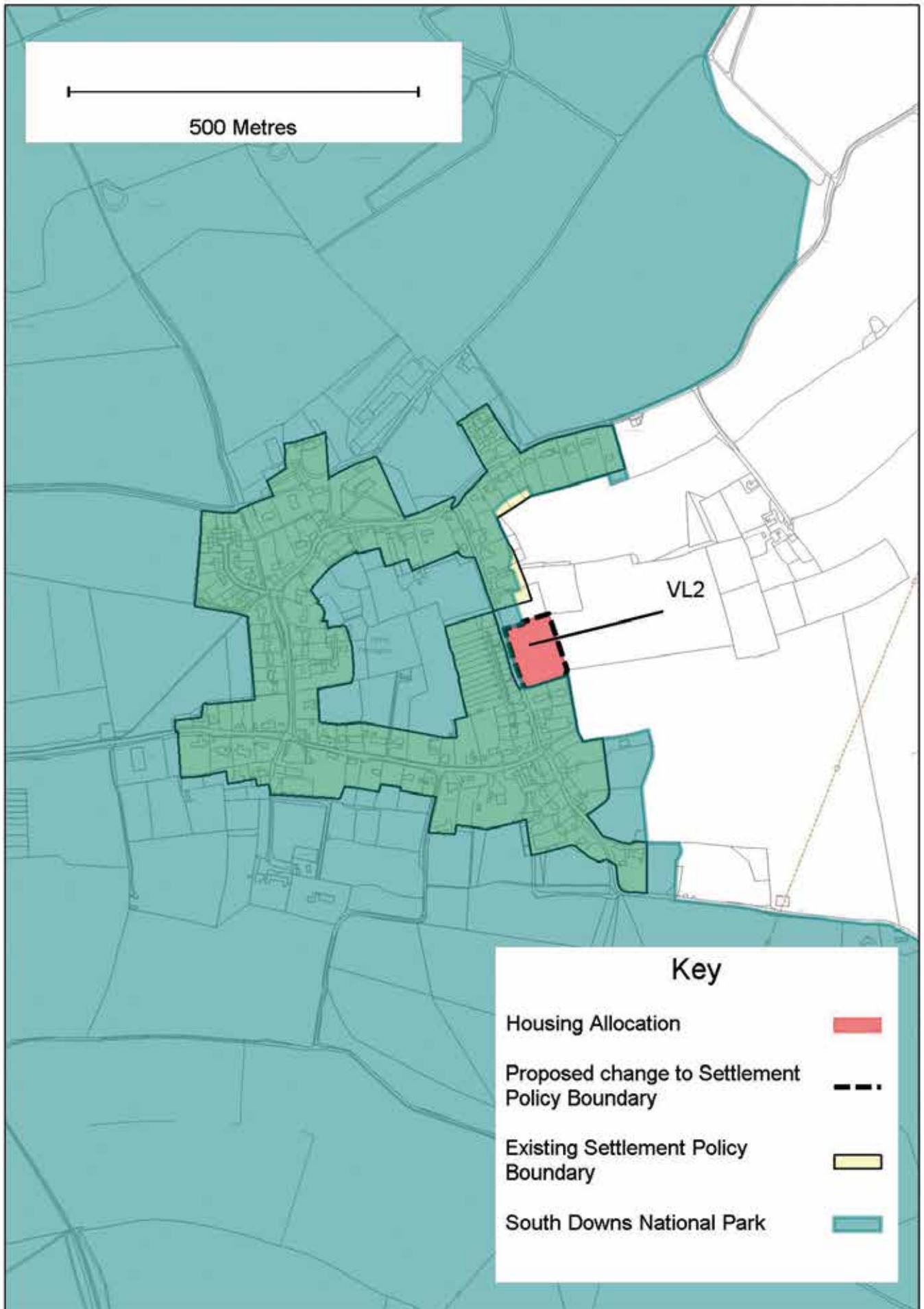
Map 6 - Four Marks and South Medstead



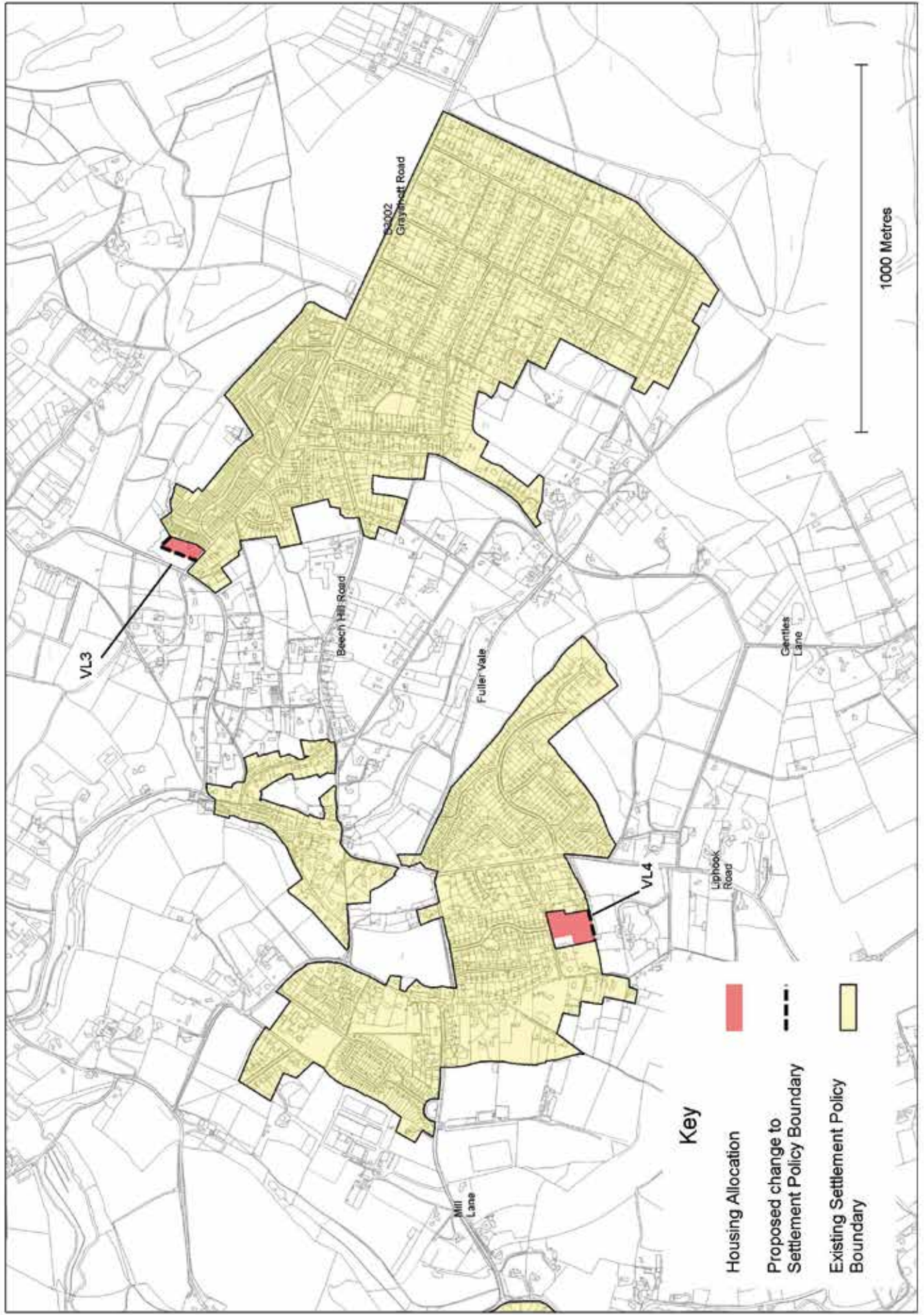

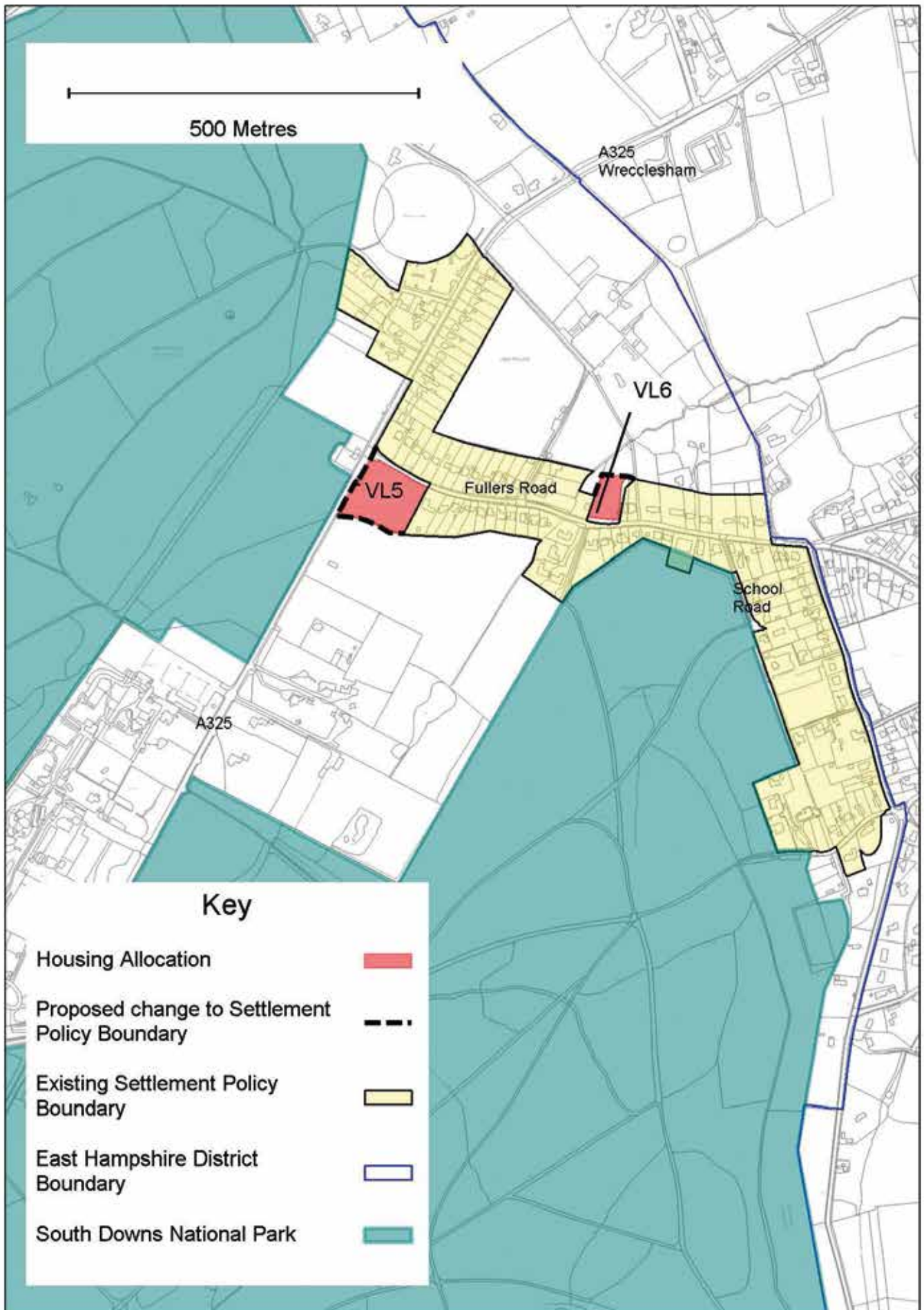

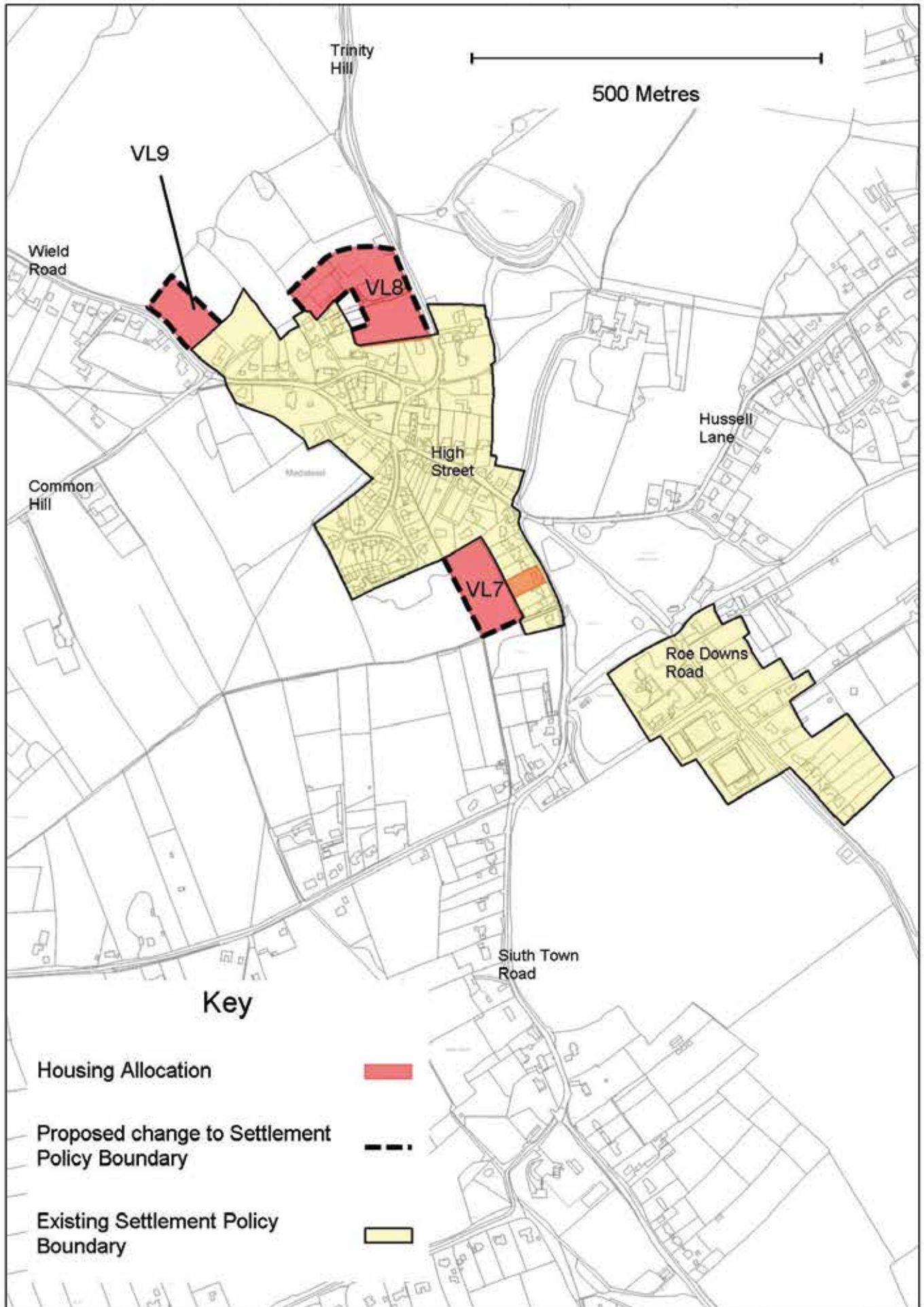

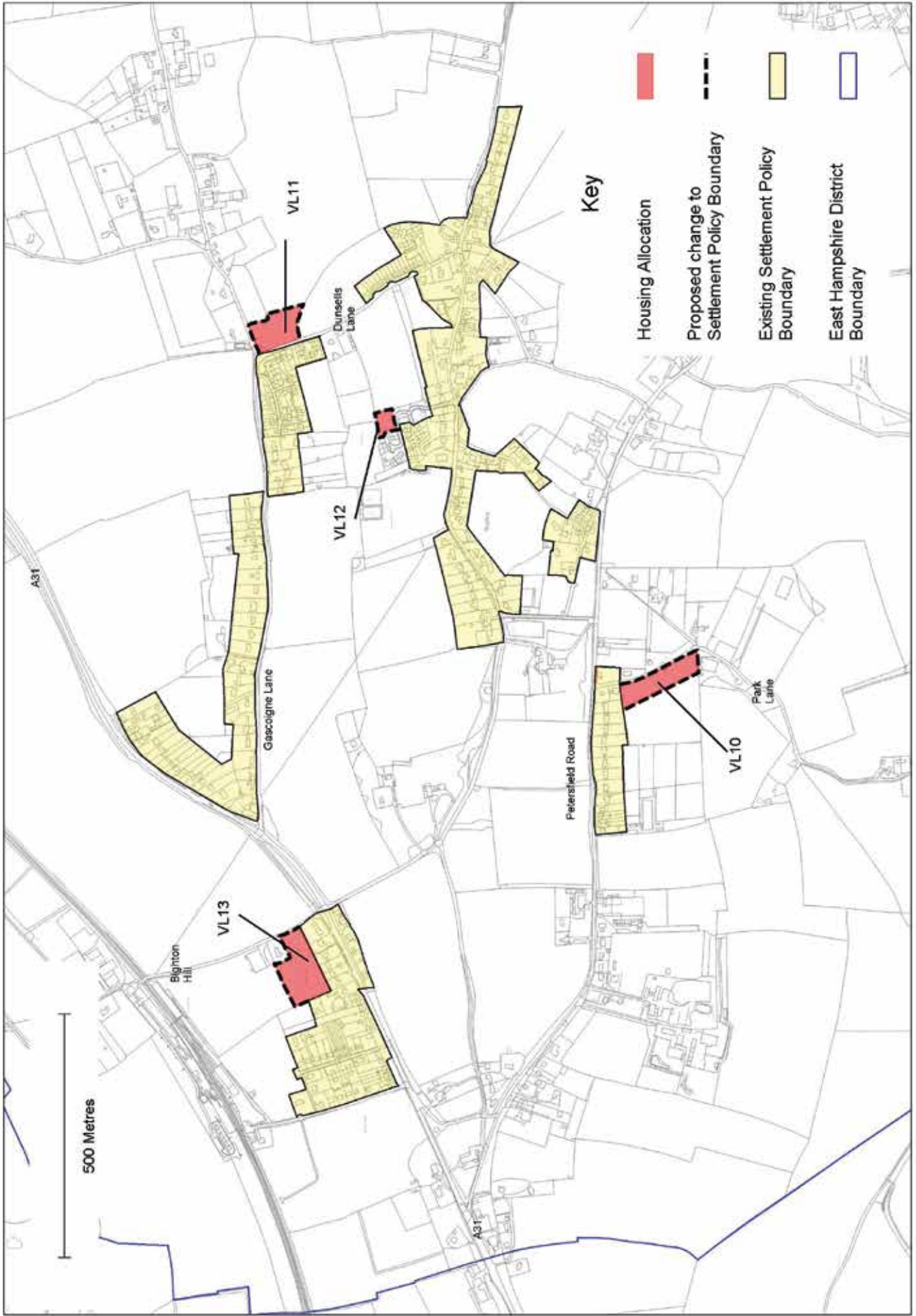
