Adoption of East Hampshire District: Residential Extensions & Householder Development Supplementary Planning Document

Statement of Adoption

19th July 2018

In accordance with Regulation 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that East Hampshire District Council adopted the East Hampshire Residential Extensions & Householder Development Supplementary Planning Document on 19 July 2018. This SPD was prepared to support the implementation of policies CP27 (Pollution) and CP29 (Design) of the Joint Core Strategy.

The adopted Residential Extensions & Householder Development Supplementary Planning Document covers those parts of East Hampshire District located outside of the South Downs National Park.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted.
