

The East Hampshire District Statement of Community Involvement

Clarification in relation to General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

This note is prepared to update references in the Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) that refer to the use and storage of personal data.

The Council runs public consultations when it is preparing a new Local Plan or other related Local Plan documents (such as Supplementary Planning Documents). The representations received during the consultation cannot be anonymous – however, whilst the Council will publish the content of the representations received, it will not publish any personal information in relation to the person(s) who submitted the representation. For clarity, the name of the individual, their address, email address or signature will not be published. The Council will publish the name of the organisation (such as a Parish Council, District Council or Infrastructure provider) if applicable, but not the name of the individual.

The SCI refers to how you can be kept up to date on Local Plan stages and consultations by registering on the Planning Policy Consultation Database. The Council no longer operates a Planning Policy Consultation Database, from which those that have responded previously to Local Plan consultations are notified. Instead, if you wish to be kept up to date on the progress of the Local Plan and forthcoming consultations – you need to sign up to receive updates from the Council on the homepage of the website and select email alerts (www.easthants.gov.uk). From here, you will be able to select which information you wish to receive, including information about Planning and Local Plans. You will also be able to unsubscribe at any time. The Council only maintains a Local Plan mailing list for Statutory Consultees.
