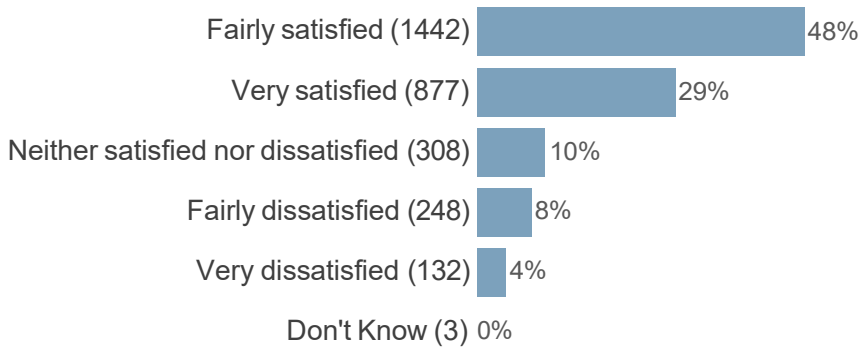


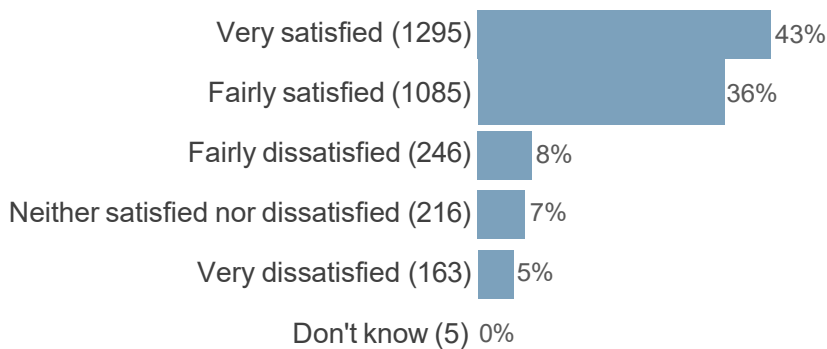

Overall, how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with your local area as a place to live?



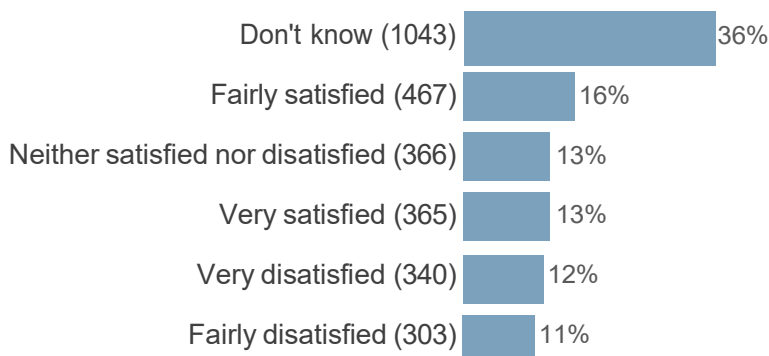
Satisfaction with the local authority

How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the way East Hampshire District Council runs the following services: **(Bin collection)**



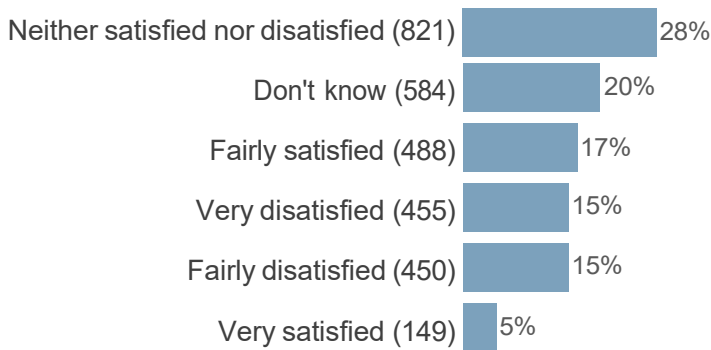

How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the way East Hampshire District Council runs the following services: **(Garden waste collection)**



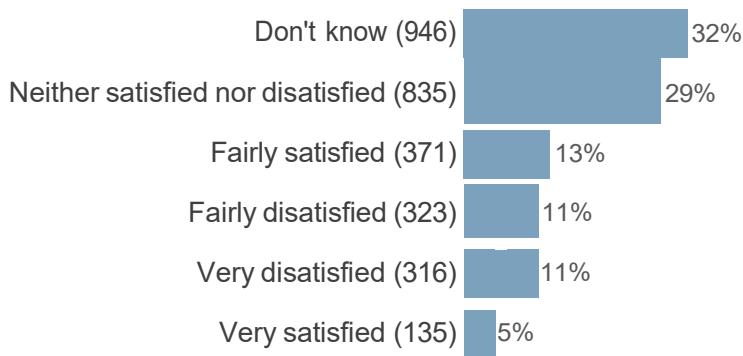

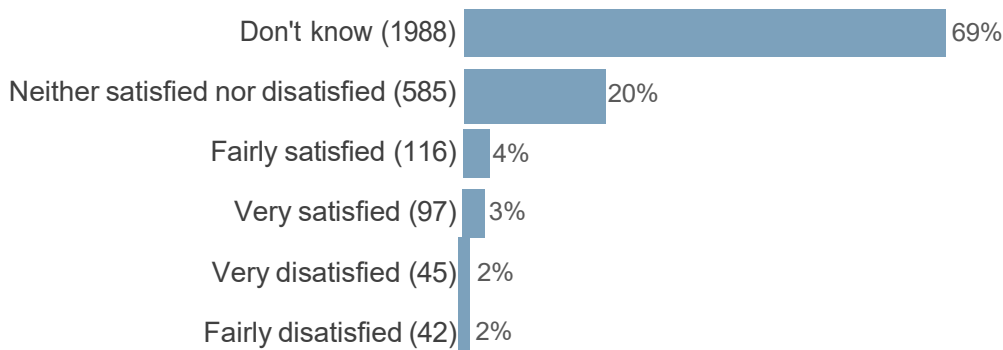

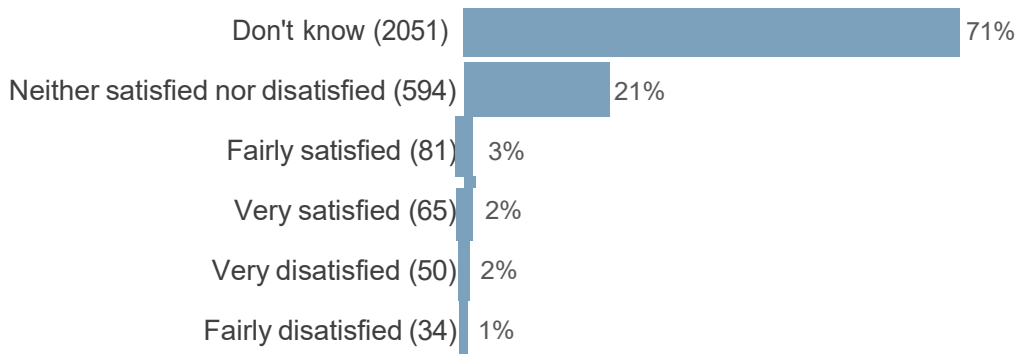

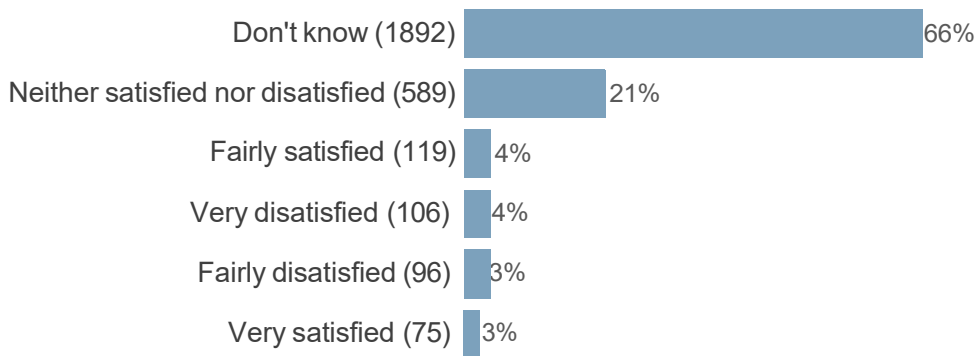

Did you know that out of every pound you pay for council tax EHDC recieves just seven pence?

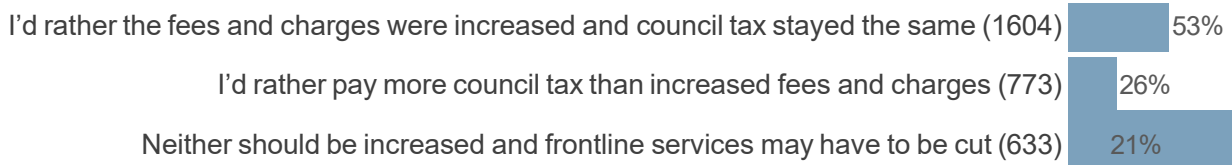

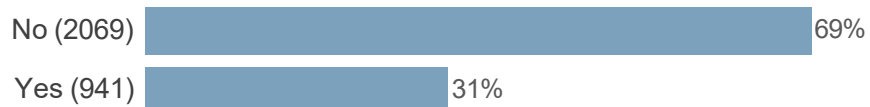


Our strategy is to achieve net zero carbon by 2035.

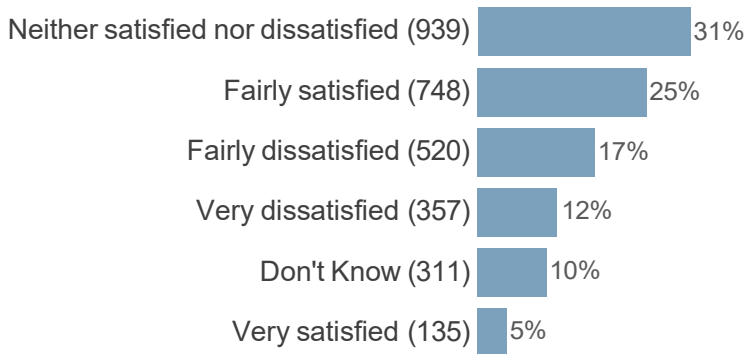


Would you be prepared to pay more council tax to support the 'green agenda'?

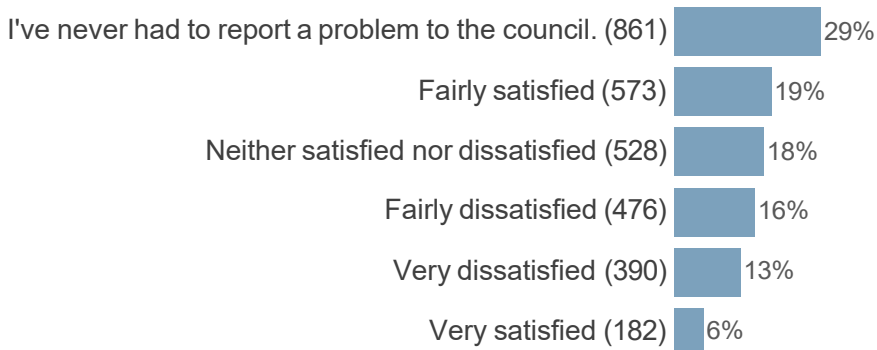

How satisfied are you that East Hampshire District Council acts on the concerns of local residents?

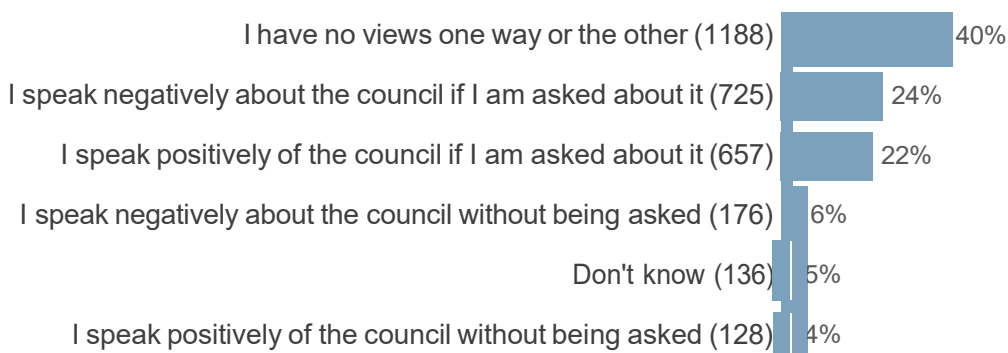


If you report a problem to the council, how satisfied are you with the outcome?



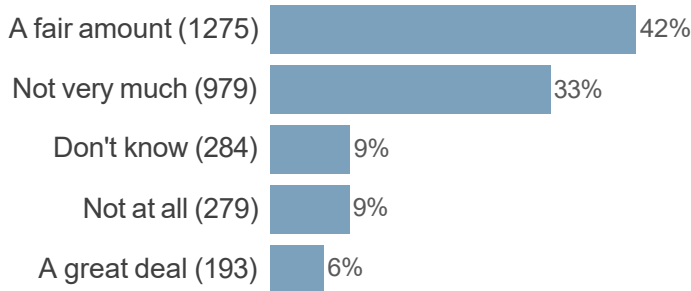

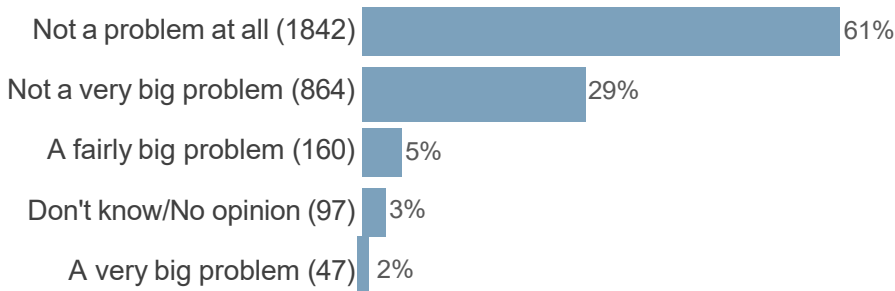

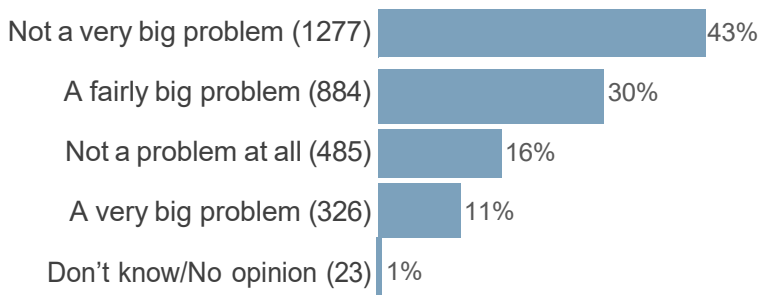

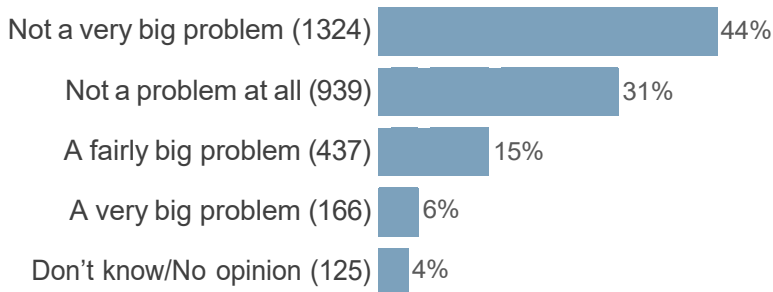
Thinking about this local area, how much of a problem do you think each of the following is for you... **(Noisy neighbours or loud parties)**



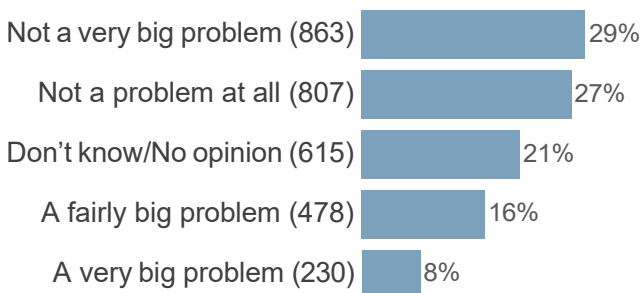
Anti-social behaviour Thinking about this local area, how much of a problem do you think each of the following is for you... **(Rubbish or litter lying around)**



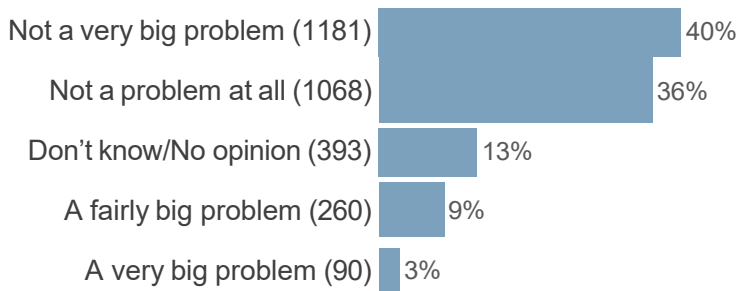

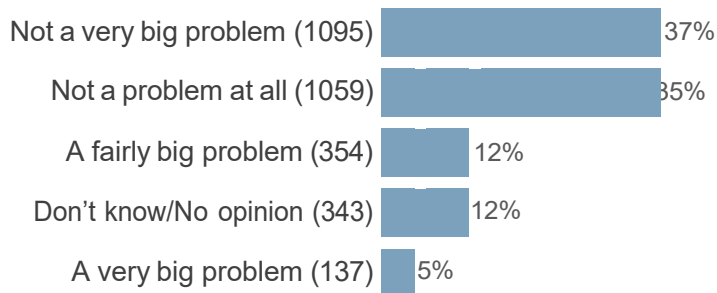

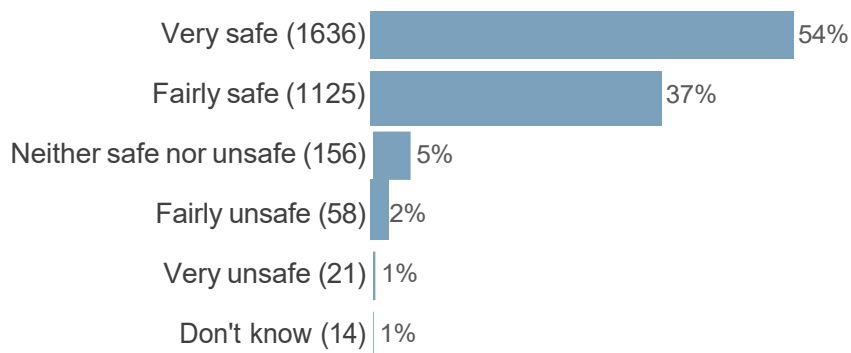

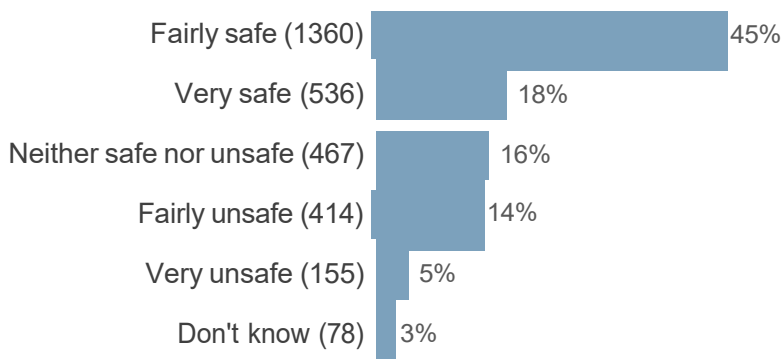

How safe or unsafe do you feel when outside in your local area during the day? **(Noisy neighbours or loud parties)**

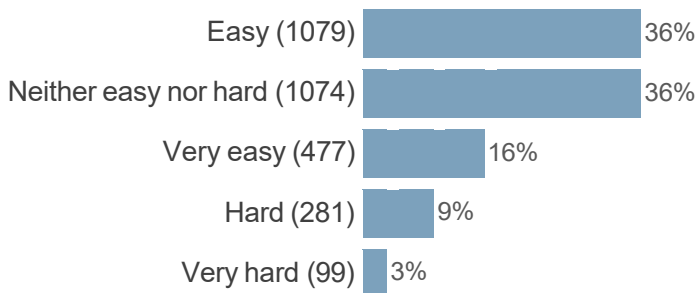


Community safety after dark

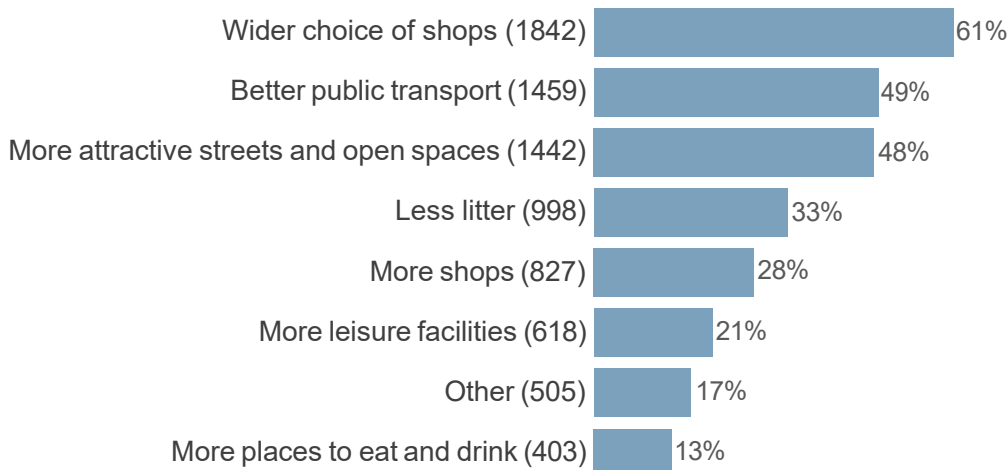
How safe or unsafe do you feel when outside in your local area after dark?



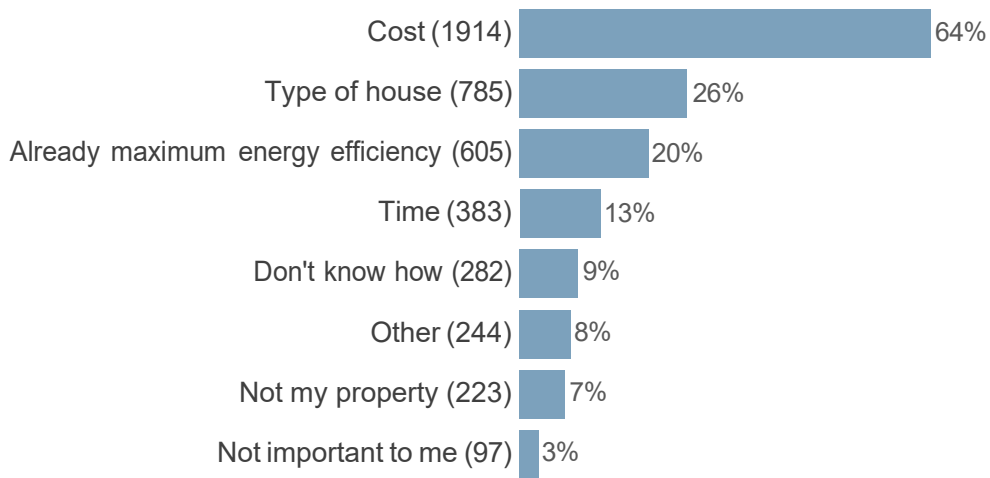
