Consultation Statement for Statement of Community Involvement 2024

A 5-week public consultation occurred between 8th July and 9th August 2024 on the revision of the Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) (2024). In summary, the SCI has been updated to reflect more digital forms of community engagement and simplified to include visual images rather than lengthy descriptions of planning processes both plan making and planning applications. The document also includes up to date contact details and associated arrangements now that the Council has moved to its new offices.

The representations received are detailed below, as well as the comments and actions undertaken by policy officers in response.
