




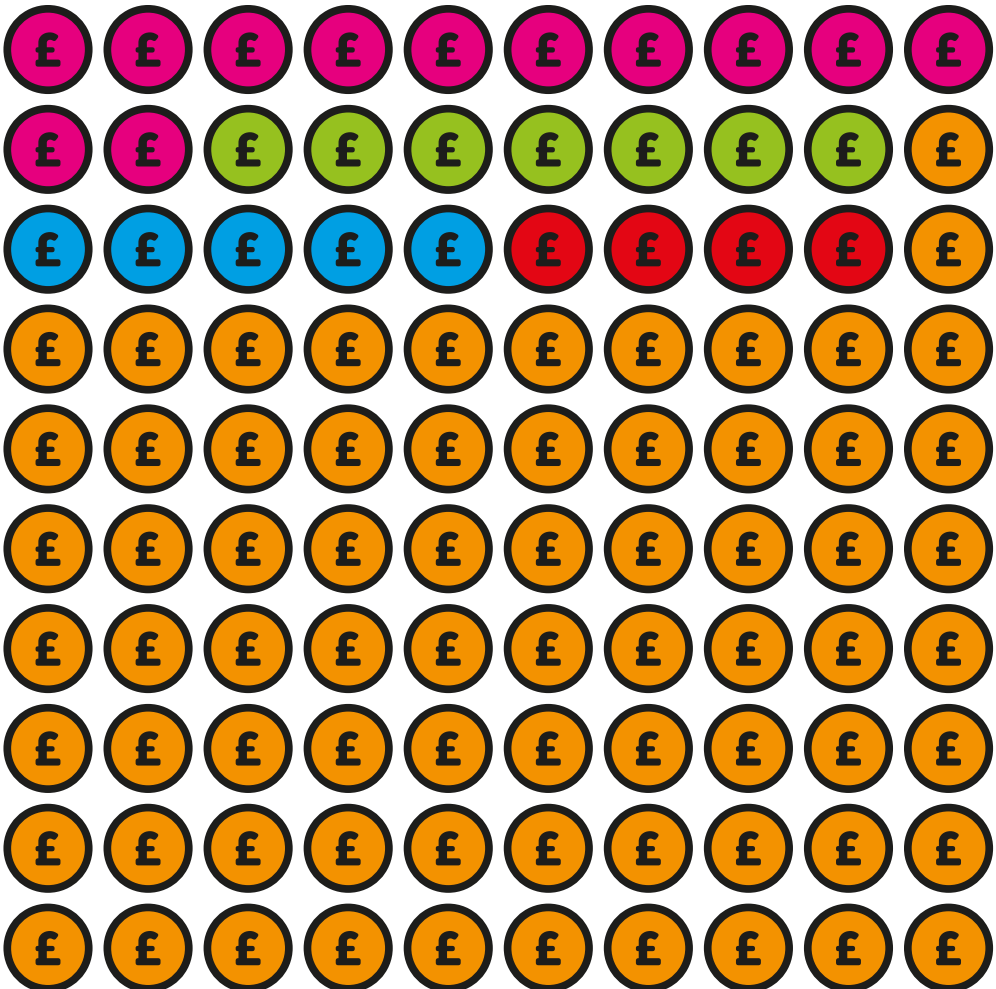


WHERE YOUR COUNCIL TAX GOES



East Hampshire District Council (EHDC) collects council tax and distributes it to other local authorities and emergency services.

For every £1 you pay in council tax, Hampshire Police and Crime Commissioner  gets 12p, EHDC  gets 7p, your town or parish council  gets an average of 5p, Hampshire Fire and Rescue Authority  gets 4p and Hampshire County Council  gets 72p.
